HOUSE BILL NO. 1330

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 50 of chapter 257 of the 2013 Session Laws, relating to the contingent effective date for implementation of the electronic filing system.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50 of chapter 257 of the 2013 Session Laws is amended and reenacted as follows:

**SECTION 50. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE.** Sections 1 through 27 and sections 29 through 47 of this Act become effective August 1, ~~2015~~2016, or earlier if the secretary of state makes a report to the legislative management and to the information technology committee certifying that the information technology components of the electronic filing system are ready for implementation of those provisions of this Act, in which case those sections become effective ninety days following the completion of the certificate requirement.
