

**Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

SENATE BILL NO. 2125
(Industry, Business and Labor Committee)
(At the request of the Public Service Commission)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 64-02-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to public service commission action for weighing or measuring devices that do not meet design or tolerance standards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 64-02-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

64-02-14. Incorrect weighing or measuring devices -~~Power to seize, condemn, or destroy.~~

~~The commission shall condemn, seize, or destroy any incorrect weighing or measuring device which cannot be satisfactorily repaired. Those~~A weighing or measuring devices which are incorrect but which are capable of being repaired~~device that does not meet applicable design or tolerance requirements~~ must be marked as "rejected for repair" in the manner set by the commission. ~~The owner or user of a weighing or measuring device which has been so marked shall have it repaired or corrected within thirty days, and the device may not be used or disposed of within that thirty day period in commerce without the consent of the commission.~~
