
AN ACT to amend and reenact section 26.1-26.6-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to commissions, premiums, fees, and mileage reimbursement charged by bail bond agents.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-26.6-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**26.1-26.6-08. Maximum commission or fee - Mileage.**

A bail bond agent may not charge a premium, commission, or fee for a bond in an amount more than ~~tent~~twenty percent of the amount of bail furnished by the bail bond agent, or ~~seventy-five~~one hundred fifty dollars, whichever is greater. In addition to the premium, commission, or fee charged under this section, a bail bond agent may charge for mileage reimbursement, which may not exceed mileage reimbursement rates provided for state employees under section 54-06-09.
