

**Sixty-seventh Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

HOUSE BILL NO. 1039
(Legislative Management)
(Legislative Procedure and Arrangements Committee)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 48-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a media room in the state capitol; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 48-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

48-08-03. ~~Press representatives'~~Media room in state capitol.

The director of the office of management and budget shall set aside a room in the state capitol for the exclusive use of ~~accredited representatives of daily and other newspapers and full-time correspondents of accredited press associations~~the media and shall place the statehouse ~~correspondent of the associated press~~North Dakota newspaper association and North Dakota broadcasters association jointly in charge of such ~~press~~the room.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
