HOUSE BILL NO. 1230
(Representatives Satrom, Jones, K. Koppelman)
(Senators Conley, Myrdal)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 25-13-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of a service animal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 25-13-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

25-13-01.1. Definitions.

For purposes of this chapter "service animal" means any guide dog, ~~signal dog, or other animal~~ trained to do work, perform tasks, or provide assistance for the benefit of an individual with a disability. The term includes ~~an animal~~ a dog trained to provide assistance ~~or protection services~~ to an individual with a disability, pull a wheelchair, lend balance support, retrieve dropped objects, or provide assistance in a medical crisis.
