(Representatives Becker, Christensen, Cory, Kempenich, Nehring)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 29-01-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the compromise of misdemeanors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 29-01-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

29-01-19. Compromise limited.

A public offense may not be compromised, nor may any proceeding for the prosecution or punishment thereof of a public offense, upon a compromise, be stayed except as is provided in sections 29-01-16 and 29-01-17 and with the consent of the state.
