

**Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

HOUSE BILL NO. 1364
(Representative Pollert)
(Senator Carlisle)

AN ACT to provide an appropriation to the department of veterans' affairs; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS - 2013-15 BIENNIUM.

There is appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, the sum of \$380,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of providing transportation services to veterans or for purchasing vehicles for the provision of transportation-related services to veterans, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
