HOUSE BILL NO. 1417
(Representative Louser)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 11-11-50 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an armed services' room in courthouses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-11-50 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

11-11-50. Former members of armed services' room in courthouses.

The board of county commissioners shall equip and maintain an adequate room in the courthouse or county office building for the exclusive priority preference use of former members of the armed services who served in any war in which of the United States has been engaged if the county seat has a population of over ten thousand inhabitants and a memorial building has not been erected in such municipality.
