HOUSE BILL NO. 1436
(Representatives Schreiber-Beck, Longmuir, Pyle, Zubke)
(Senator Oban)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to summer school courses; and to declare an emergency.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:


1. a. ~~Remedial mathematics~~Mathematics provided to students enrolled in any grade from kindergarten through eight;
- b. ~~Remedial reading~~Reading provided to students enrolled in any grade from kindergarten through eight;
- c. ~~Beginning after the conclusion of the 2009-10 school calendar, mathematics provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through eight;~~
- d. ~~Beginning after the conclusion of the 2009-10 school calendar, reading provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through eight;~~
- e. ~~Beginning after the conclusion of the 2009-10 school calendar, science~~Science provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through eight; and
- f. ~~Beginning after the conclusion of the 2009-10 school calendar, social~~
- d. Social studies provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through eight; and

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.




