

**Sixty-seventh Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

SENATE BILL NO. 2126
(Senators Kreun, Clemens, Myrdal)
(Representatives Jones, O'Brien)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 43-30-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the membership of the private investigative and security board; and to provide for application.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-30-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

43-30-03. Private investigative and security board.

The governor shall appoint a private investigative and security board. The board must consist of not ~~less~~fewer than five nor more than eleven members appointed for staggered four-year terms. ~~Appointees to~~When making appointments, the governor shall consider whether there is member representation from the western, central, and eastern geographic regions of the state. Each member of the board must be knowledgeable in private investigative or private security matters. A majority of the members of the board must be actively engaged in the private investigative or security profession, with at least one member actively engaged in law enforcement. Members of the board may not receive any compensation for their service on the board, but they are entitled to ~~be reimbursed~~receive reimbursement for their expenses incurred in performing their official duties in the amounts provided by law for state employees.


SECTION 2. APPLICATION. This Act applies to board appointments made on and after the effective date of this Act.
