

**Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

SENATE BILL NO. 2237  
(Senators J. Lee, Dever, Mathern)  
(Representatives Beadle, Delmore, Hofstad)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 50-31-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to information received by the department of human services for substance abuse treatment programs; and to declare an emergency.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-31-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**50-31-06. Information confidential.**

InformationClient records and client information that are protected under title 42, Code of Federal Regulations, part 2, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 [Pub. L. 104-191; 110 Stat. 1936; 29 U.S.C. 1181 et seq.], or are specifically excluded from disclosure by other state or federal law, and which are received by the department through inspections of programs under this chapter ~~is~~are confidential and may not be disclosed except in a proceeding involving the issuance of a license. As used in this section, client records and client information does not include statistical program information or information regarding an applicant's or provider's programs.

**SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
