We, the undersigned, constituting the State Board of Canvassers, met in the office of Secretary of State on December 14, 1973 for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the Special Election held on December 4, 1973 and we hereby certify that the following Abstract of Votes cast for the Constitutional Measure (Amendment) and Referred Statute (Measure) and for the election of a Senator from the 5th Legislative District and Representatives from the 3rd, 18th, 22nd and 29th Legislative District, is a correct abstract as the same has been certified to us by the various County Auditors of the state, and according to the canvassers of such returns, as so certified by the said auditors, and we do hereby certify that the following persons were duly elected to their respective offices and we do hereby certify that the Constitution Measure (Amendment) and Referred Statute (Measure) is approved or disapproved as shown herein

CONSTITUTIONAL MEASURE (AMENDMENT)

No 1 Requiring that the state be divided into individual Senate Districts and House sub-districts by an appointed nine-member commission and repealing Sections 26, 29, 32, 35 and 214 of the Constitution of North Dakota
Disapproved 53,831 to 43,178

REFERRED STATUTE (MEASURE)

No 1 Referendum of House Bill No 1042, the state legislative apportionment plan providing for thirty-seven legislative districts with fifty Senators and two Representatives per Senator
Disapproved 50,729 to 44,363
