

**Sixty-eighth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota
In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 3, 2023**

HOUSE BILL NO. 1196
(Representatives Pyle, Heilman, Karls, Rohr, Schreiber-Beck)
(Senators Lemm, Rust)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to free tuition for dependents of disabled veterans or veterans killed in action.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15-10-18.3. Free tuition in North Dakota institutions of higher education.

Any~~an~~^A dependent, as defined in section 15-10-18.2, upon being duly accepted for enrollment into ~~any~~^{an} undergraduate degree or certificate program of a North Dakota state institution of higher education, must be allowed to obtain a bachelor's degree or certificate of completion, for so long as the dependent is eligible, free of any tuition and fee charges ~~if the bachelor's degree or certificate of completion is earned within a forty-five month or ten-semester period or its equivalent and~~ if tuition and fee charges do not include costs for aviation flight charges or expenses. Once an individual qualifies as a dependent under ~~sections~~^{section} 15-10-18.2 and ~~15-10-18.3~~^{this section}, the dependent may not be disqualified from the benefits of this section:

1. Due to the return of the prisoner of war;
2. Due to the return of the individual missing in action; or
3. Because the veteran through whom the benefit was obtained had a one hundred percent service-connected disability at the time of death.
