HOUSE BILL NO. 1529

AN ACT to provide for a legislative management study relating to campaign finance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE ELECTIONS LAW. During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the provisions of chapter 16.1-08.1 related to campaign contribution statements for purposes of eliminating duplicative provisions, clarifying inconsistent or unclear provisions, pursuing uniformity for required contribution and expenditure reports, and rearranging provisions in a logical order. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
