HOUSE BILL NO. 1082 (Agriculture Committee) (At the request of the Agriculture Commissioner)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 36-25-01 of North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of farmed elk.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 36-25-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

36-25-01. Definitions.

In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 1. "Board" means the state board of animal health.
- 2. "Commissioner" means the agriculture commissioner.
- 3. "Farmed elk" means mammals of the elk family (cervus elaphus), except red deer, North American elk genus and species (cervus canadensis) confined in a manmade enclosure designed to prevent escape and:
 - a. Raised for fiber, meat, or animal byproducts;
 - b. Raised for breeding, exhibition, or harvest; or
 - c. Maintained for any other purpose.
- 4. "Owner" means a person who owns or is responsible for the raising of farmed elk.
