HOUSE BILL NO. 1103  
(Representatives Beltz, Dobervich, Hagert, Kiefert, Nehring, Tveit)  
(Senators Hogan, Lemm, Weber)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 4.1-07-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definitions applying to the dry pea and lentil council.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 5 of section 4.1-07-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

5. "Producer" means any person that:
  - a. Plants or causes to be planted a dry pea and lentil crop in which the person has an ownership interest, with the intent that upon maturity the crop will be harvested; or
  - b. ~~Will have met the requirements of subdivision a during the next available growing season; or~~
  - e. ~~Has met the requirements of subdivision a during the immediately preceding growing season~~planted and subsequently will plant a dry pea and lentil crop as part of the person's crop rotation within a six-year period.
